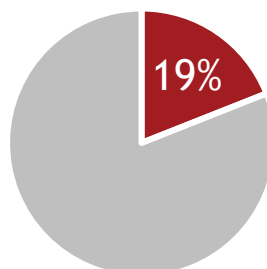

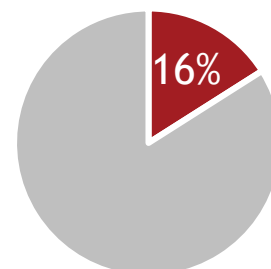
Health Coverage (2010-2014 ACS 5-Year Estimates)
