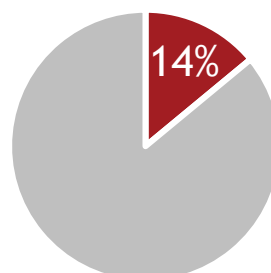

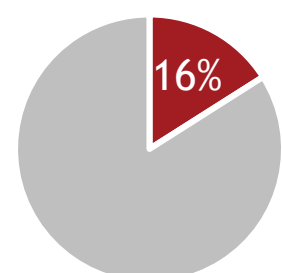
Percent of people with *no health insurance coverage*:
