I. Reviewing Cuyahoga Facilitation Guide

- a. Do we want to use this guide for our stakeholder's event?
- b. Can do a 30-minute training to set expectations for facilitators and note-takers
- c. Things to add:
 - i. Add language around lowering infections
 - ii. "What prompted you to sign up for the event?"
 - iii. "What are some of the barriers that keep you from getting tested (instead of prevents)?"
 1. Add: "What have you heard/what do you think keeps others from getting tested"; What would make it easier for you to access services? (be specific about whether it is treatment/prevention)
 - iv. Use simpler language as some may not understand what it means to reduce transmissions
 1. (keep at 6th grade reading level)
 - v. What do you think might make people want to come in for treatment/what have you heard? (Change language for those that may not be providers)
 1. What has not been successful in ...?
 - vi. Use words like medical care/doctor instead of "treatment" or "services"
 - vii. "In a perfect world what would the best-case scenario look like for getting an HIV test or accessing care?"
 1. Encourages innovation in answers
 - viii. Use more language asking "How can we improve....?"
 - ix. Ask about power dynamics and ask if community members, etc. feel they have a say in decisions
 - x. "What do we need to move forward?"—too vague, will remove
 - xi. "What programs and services are we missing in this community?"
 1. Make more specific to areas w/in the 4 pillars (treatment and prevention)
