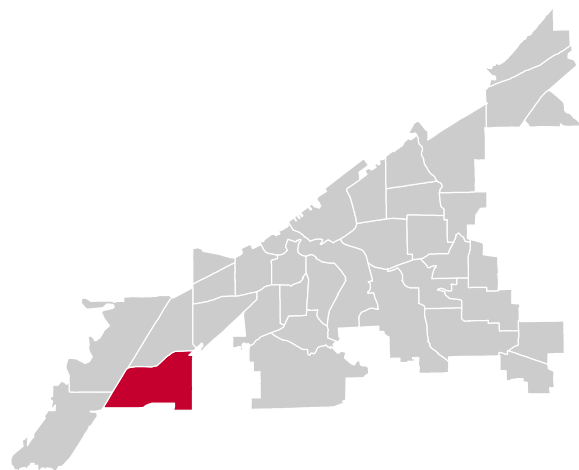

Food Bank Benefits Eligibility



3 in 5 Bellaire-Puritas residents, 7,842 total, live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.

Internet Access
