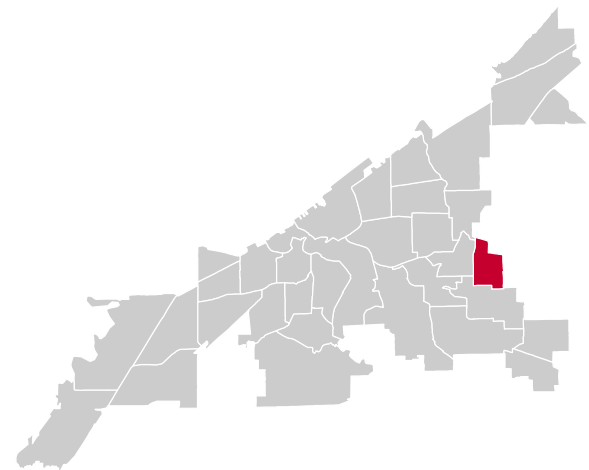

Food Bank Benefits Eligibility



5 in 10 Buckeye-Shaker Square residents, 5,758 total, live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.

Internet Access
