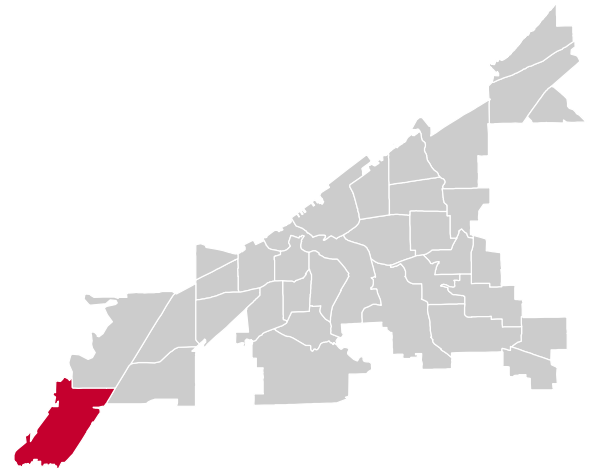

Food Bank Benefits Eligibility



2 in 5 Hopkins residents, 132 total, live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.

Internet Access

About 1 in 4 households in Hopkins live in housing that is unaffordable to them, meaning their housing costs exceed 30% of the gross household income.
