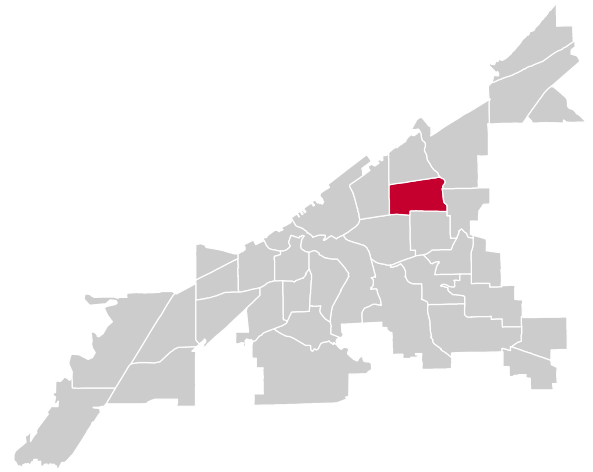

## Food Bank Benefits Eligibility



**7 in 10 Hough residents, 6,954 total,** live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.
