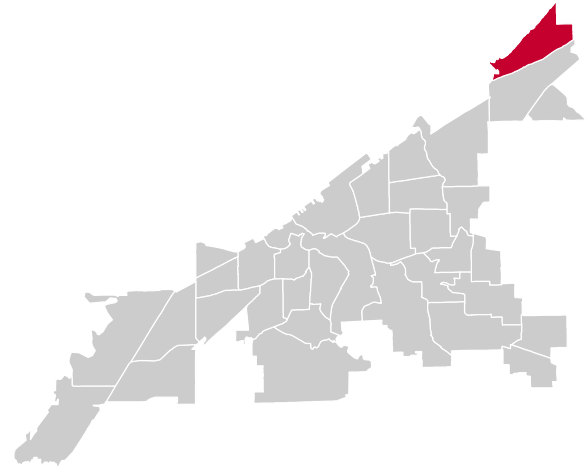

5 in 10 North Shore Collinwood residents, 8,405 total, live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.

Internet Access
