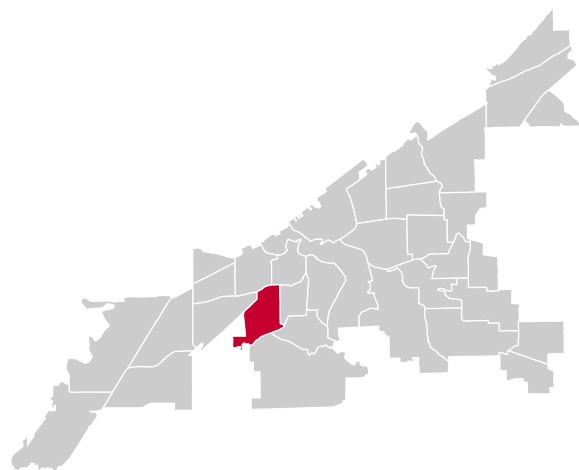

Food Bank Benefits Eligibility



7 in 10 Stockyards residents, 7,167 total, live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.
