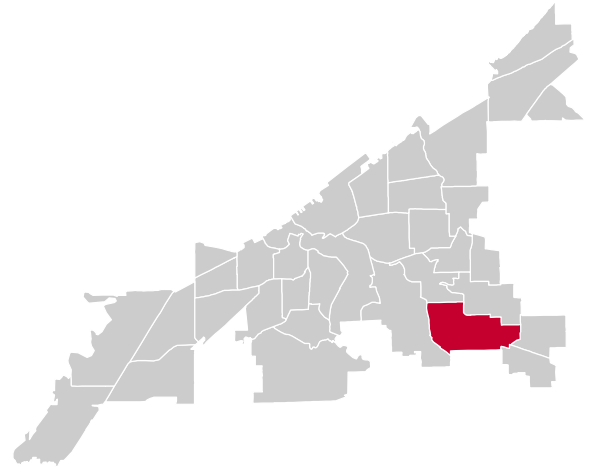

3 in 5 Union-Miles residents, 10,154 total, live at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, which means they are eligible to receive food bank benefits.

Internet Access
