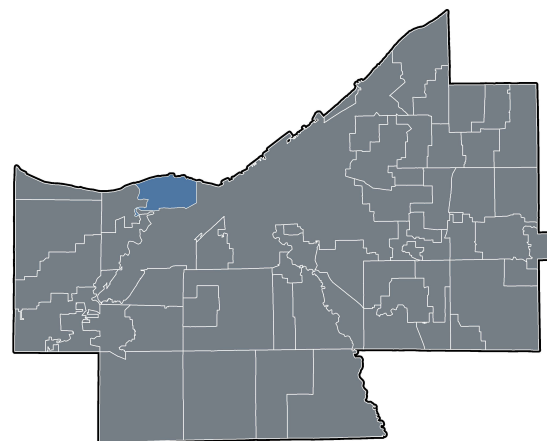

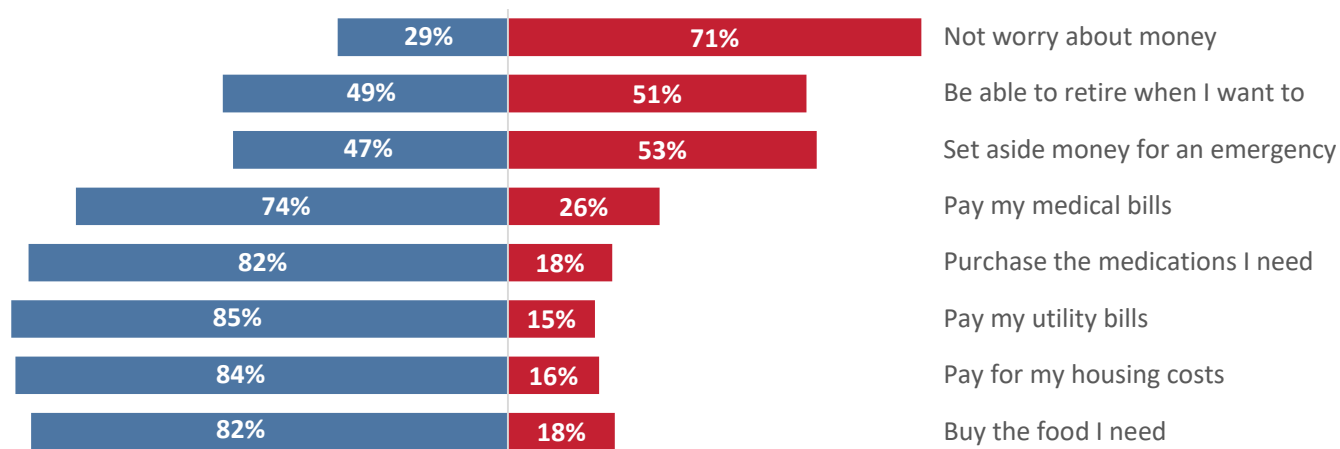

One in four (24.8 percent) residents do not have access to mental health/ counseling services every time they need it.

Nine out of ten (89.3 percent) residents have visited their primary care provider in the last year.



Four in five (81.8 percent) residents have someone who can always answer their health-related questions.
