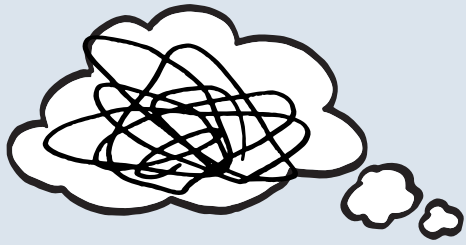

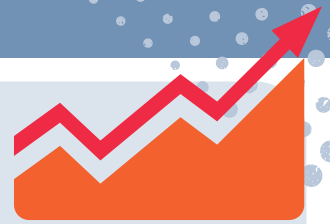

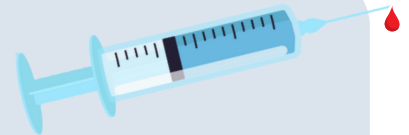
Ohio is 1 of 27 states **without state legislation to fund and implement 988**, the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline

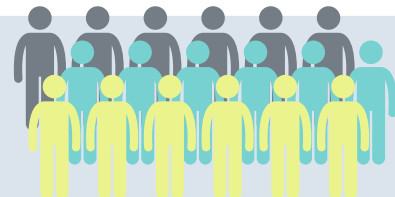
Ohio is 4th in the nation in **drug overdose deaths**

From 2011-20, **Ohioans aged 20-24 accounted for 57%** of suicides among ages 10-24. Youth aged 20-24 died by suicide at a rate of **39% in 2018, the highest in the past decade**. Veterans and LGBTQ+ people are at particular risk for suicidal ideation.
